

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The 2nd Chance Trail Ride Society practices good horsemanship. We welcome both wagon drivers and horseback riders to this event. The safety of all drivers, riders and horses is paramount, particularly in an event of this size. Please read and be familiar with the following rules and regulations.

Every driver, rider and participant needs to register at the registration desk. Every driver, rider and participant must sign a waiver before the ride begins.

ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL

The minimum age of any horse entering the ride is 3 years of age; well mannered and well conditioned. With so many participants this might not be the best ride for an inexperienced rider and/or green horse, especially after a long winter.

Do not bring a horse that shows any sign of illness, or has been contact with ill horses. The 2nd CTR Society practices and promotes good bio-security practices.

All riders are to remain behind the designated wagon leader.

Helmet use is mandatory by all children.

No crowding of horses. Please leave a minimum of 1 horse length between you and horse in front of you. Give adequate space between horses and wagons.

We encourage the full one hour lunch break to be used as a rest period for riders and horses.

We reserve the right to request that a rider and horse be withdrawn during the ride due to poor manners or unsafe horsemanship. We also request that kickers and stallions be identified with a red ribbon on the tail. Ribbons are available at registration. Stallions must be double tied.

No dogs allowed on trail. Dogs must be leashed in camp. The pooch is best left at home.

Horses, feed and transportation are the responsibility of the riders. Water will be available. For biosecurity reasons, bring your own pails for water.

Be aware that this is not a private trail and you may encounter ATVs and other users of the trail. It is suggested by the Iron Horse Trail that ATVs are to slow to an idle or stop to allow equestrian riders to pass. Any garbage you have from throughout the day should be held onto until it can be discarded properly.

There will be multiple Trail Bosses on the ride, if there should be a medical emergency please notify one of them so the proper authorities can be contacted and medical care can be given.

Thank you in advance for your respect and acknowledgement of our rules and regulations. We hope has a positive experience and helps in spreading the word that organ and tissue donation works.
